

LAW ENFORCEMENT ANTI TERROR & PREPAREDNESS TRAINING

THURSDAY OCTOBER 11TH THROUGH SUNDAY OCTOBER 14TH

Gary Drake of Elwha Police Department in conjunction with Domestic Security Service is proud to host four days of intense training, persons representing Federal, Police and Military agencies may apply. This will be a no nonsense event with little sleep and lots of challenges. We have arranged for trainers from a variety of backgrounds, police, military and the private sector. As you know, our first responders are the first line of defense for our country on U.S. soil. We have all seen events in recent history (Katrina, 9.11 Columbine, Beslan etc.) that show us we must learn to be prepared for and respond to any type of an event. We feel it would be better to make your mistakes during training, not when our children's lives and our countries future may be at stake. Expect the unexpected during this training, know that you must always be prepared!

Training will take place at the Elwha Police Department facility near Port Angeles Washington. A large wooded area is available to us and will allow for additional challenges. We will be using Sim weapons, with a handful to share. If you have not fitted your own weapon, try to do it before this event, you will be more comfortable!

After periods of training, you and or your team will be given a brief of the challenge you face. In some cases it will be detailed, in others it may be vague, as it is on the job. You may need to stop an active shooter, breach a mock nuclear facility to stop a terrorist cell from destroying it, serve a warrant at a meth lab in the woods, stop a terrorist group from blowing up a school, stop a home invasion (at your house), stop terrorists from cutting off one of your brothers heads as the clock ticks.....I thing your starting to get the idea! Bring you're "A" game, you'll need it! If your still developing it, that's ok as well. We are all students of this game, and even the best face new challenge each day.

We ask that you bring all of the equipment you need to support yourself in this activity. October can be cold and wet. Cary water and enough portable food for at least twelve hours, field events may go long. Bring a compass, flash light and whistle. For the range you will need to bring 300 rounds for your pistol and 100 for your assault rifle.

This will be first come first serve, we have only a limited number of slots for this training, so register now. We will only be asking for donations from you or your department (you can use \$100 per day, per person as a bench mark), we don't want cost to be the reason our nations best can't attend this unique training experience.
